My name is Heather Kuiper and I am a California native whose education spanned the pre- and post-Prop 13 eras, so I experienced firsthand the rapid and utter devastation of our once outstanding public education system, once vibrant cities, parks, libraries, and cultural programs. I support Proposition 15 for numerous reasons, including its restoration of a desperately needed portion of funding for schools and communities. I also support it because it is smart business. For California to remain competitive, it needs to be a place that people want to live, with quality public amenities, education, and services. Prop 15 will allow that California to return to that quality of life that now more than ever determines people's choice of residence. Additionally, for California to be competitive, it needs to produce an educated, capable population, which requires investment in our education and community services.
