## Comment:

I voted against Proposition 19 because of the provision that was slipped into The Home Protection for Seniors, Severely Disabled, Families and Victims of Wildfire or Natural Disasters Act regarding Parent-Child & Grandparent-Grandchild Exclusion. This act constitutes "LEGAL THEFT AGAINST TAXPAYERS WITHOUT NOTICE." The public was totally misled and now you are in the process of legally clarifying the gray areas - AFTER THE FACT - that needs to be resolved in order to implement this Proposition. However, you've given a hard date of February 16, 2021 for parents to transfer their properties to their children in order to obtain the Exclusion before the law is finalized. Obviously, someone is in a hurry to take advantage of this license to steal. The Assessor's office and BOE cannot answer any questions because Implementing the statue - IS YET TO BE DETERMINED.
