TO COUNTY ASSESSORS:

BUILDING COST INDICES

Enclosed is a copy of the Building Cost Indices table which contains a series of annual building cost indices based on the current year. Original and historical costs may be trended to reflect the current cost level by multiplying the original cost by the proper factor for the year that the building was constructed.

EXAMPLE

A brick building built in 1990 had an original cost of \$600,000. Trending the original cost of this building by the appropriate factor from the enclosed table results in the following current cost level for this property:

$$\$600,000 \times 1.61 = \$966,000$$

These factors represent a composite of the following published index factors:
