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INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this report is to supply data that is useful for comparing the operations of an assessor's office with those of other county assessors.¹ Possible uses for the data contained in this report are management/staff planning and budget development.

We would like to caution the reader to use care in comparing data contained in this report. Income, expenses, budgeted positions, and workload reported all relate to the 2017-2018 fiscal year. However, the 2018-2019 assessment roll was prepared during the 2017-2018 fiscal year, using budget and staff for that fiscal year.

This data was compiled from responses to questionnaires sent to all assessors by the Board of Equalization's Property Tax Department, County-Assessed Properties Division. Please note that the figures and totals in this report may be incomplete in that they represent a comparison of *furnished data only*. Forty-nine of the fifty-eight counties reported data; however, Calaveras, El Dorado, Glenn, Lake, Mendocino, Plumas, Sierra, Trinity, and Tulare Counties did not provide data.

Please note that the number in parentheses below the column category represents the corresponding question number in the annual questionnaire that was issued in County Assessors' Only (CAO) letter 2018/018, dated August 17, 2018.
